Tighter Speed Restrictions at Galop Island - Revised


Mariners are advised that water levels in the Galop Island area continue to decline and vary significantly with wind conditions. For this reason, **the speed limits between buoys LB 122 and LB 127** are reduced as follows:

- Vessels drafting greater than 70.0 dm are limited to 7 knots upbound and 11 knots downbound.
- ➤ Vessels drafting 70.0 dm or less are limited to 10.5 knots upbound and 13 knots downbound.

All vessels are advised to **avoid vessel meets and sailing over** the following identified high spots:

> High Spot A: 44^o 45.6693'N 075^o 24.8710'W

► High Spot B: 44^o 45.9575′N 075^o 24.4942′W



Conditions will be monitored closely and mariners will be advised of any changes.
