2019 - Notice to Shipping N° 19 MAISONNEUVE REGION MONTREAL / LAKE ONTARIO SECTION

Additional Flow Increases - Montreal Lake Ontario Section (Cancelled 2019/08/28)

Mariners are advised that in order to help alleviate flooding conditions around Lake Ontario the International Lake Ontario St. Lawrence River Board has ordered that outflows through the Moses-Saunders dam be increased in stages from 10,200 cubic metres per second (m³/s) to 10,400 m³/s as follows:

- From 10,200 m³/s to 10,250m³/s on 10 June 2019 at 00:01
- From 10,250 m³/s to 10,300m³/s on 11 June 2019 at 00:01
- From 10,300 m³/s to 10,350m³/s on 12 June 2019 at 00:01
- From 10,350 m³/s to 10,400m³/s on 13 June 2019 at 00:01

At this time, the Seaways plan to continue operations at these outflows. Mariners should exercise caution especially when navigating in areas of high cross currents including, but not limited to: Galop Island, Toussaint Island, Ogden Island, Copeland Cut, and the South Cornwall Channel (Polly's Gut).

A tug is expected to be available for assistance with the approach at Iroquois Lock beginning June 13, 2019 at 08:00.

Please note that the transit requirements outlined in Seaway Notice No. 10 will be effect when the outflows are in excess of 10,200 m³/s.

Mariners are invited to provide feedback to the Traffic Control Centers on navigation conditions encountered due to the higher than normal outflows.
